Dear Landowner:

Your Board of Directors has been discussing the issue of road work amongst an unprecedented building boom that has been going on here on the ranch. Needless to say, especially if you are currently living here the roads are taking a beating from the extra traffic of new residents as well as from the construction traffic.

This issue was also discussed during this summers annual meeting of the corporation. We asked landowners to brainstorm how we could charge a fee for road restoration considering how a large home with a basement required more trucks and ultimately did more damage to our roads versus a modest home on a crawl space. We had several good ideas from landowners that were discussed by the board after the annual meeting and at the last BOD meeting. Some research was done on a proposal to implement an "insurance bond" requirement of all new construction. This idea was ultimately rejected for various reasons.

It was finally decided to implement a new road restoration fee schedule which is graduated based on two things. 1: the size of the house/outbuilding 2: the expected amount of heavy equipment needed to complete the project. Item 1 is straightforward being based solely on the square footage of the home. Item 2 is based on whether the house/outbuilding has just a slab/ crawl space foundation or a basement. A basement would require more concrete and pumper trucks as well as heavy excavation equipment.

The following fee schedule was agreed upon and will be implemented for all new projects after September 1, 2023. Any that have been submitted for approval before that date will be grandfathered under the old road restoration fee schedule of \$1000 for a home and \$500 for an outbuilding.

Homes:

2000 sq. ft. or less \$1000. With a basement: add \$750: Total \$1750

With a crawl space : add \$250: Total \$1250

With slab foundation: included Total \$1000

2001 to 4000 sq. ft. \$1500. With a basement: add \$1000: Total \$2500

With a crawl space : add \$500: Total \$2000

4001 to 6000 sq. ft. \$2000. With a basement: add \$1500: Total \$3500

With a crawl space : add \$750: Total \$2750

6001 + sq. ft. TBD

Outbuildings:

1000 sq. ft. or less on a slab: \$500 Total \$500

1000 sq. ft. or less w/ basement: \$1000 Total \$1000

1001 to 2000 sq. ft. on a slab: \$1000 Total \$1000

1001 to 2000 sq. ft. w/basement: \$1750 Total \$1750
